Jack Petchey Award Winner



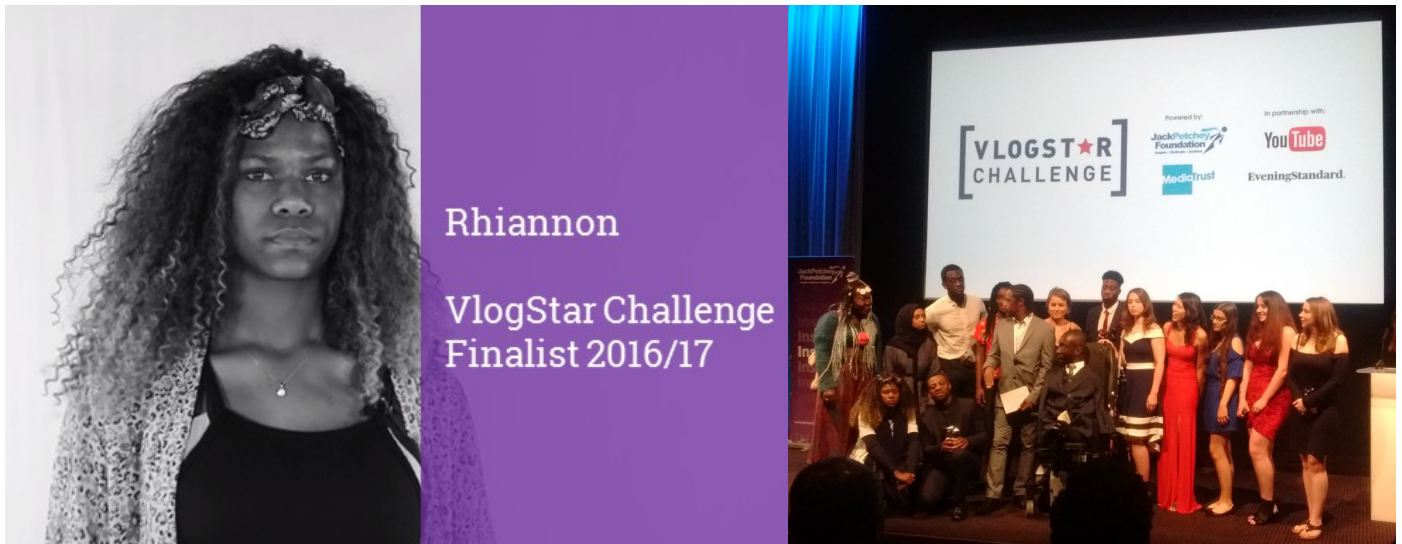
Congratulations to Isaiah (right) for receiving the Jack Petchey Achievement Award for his continuous hard work volunteering in the community!

VlogStar Challenge Finals



RDN is proud to announce that Rhiannon was the first young person from Hounslow to reach the VlogStar Challenge Finals!

The initiative aims to enable 16-24 year olds to have a platform to speak out on social issues through vlogging. The Media Trust delivered a workshop in Hounslow where participants were able to create vlogs for the competition. Rhiannon was successful in reaching the semi-finals out of 2000 entries! Her vlog addressed how young people are perceived in society.

At the semi-finals, the panel at YouTube space judged that Rhiannon's second vlog on women in society was in the top 15, out of 150 semi-finalists.

The finalists were then asked to produce one more vlog to upload to their channels on a topic of their choice. Rhiannon's submission for the final was a powerful spoken word piece on events which have affected communities in London this year.

The VlogStar Challenge Finals took place on Friday 14th July at the British Academy of Film and Television Arts in London where volunteers from RDN and family members were able to attend.

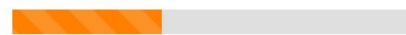
